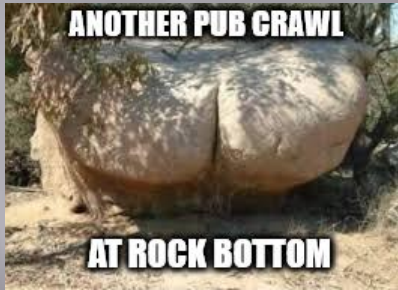

Real hikes 4 to 6 miles challenging terrain

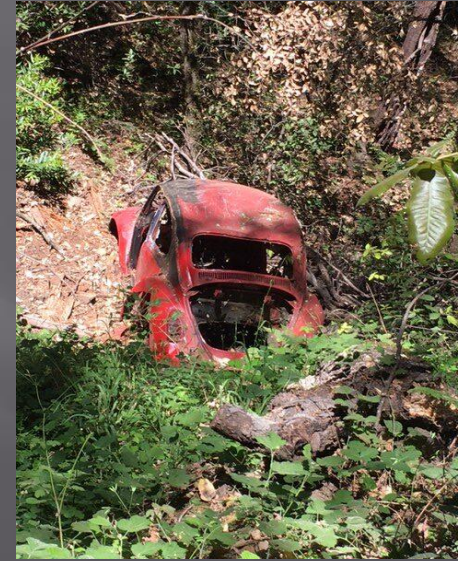
